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## Sterling Scholar Scholarships

College of Eastern Utah provides the following options for those students who participate in the Utah Sterling Scholar Program. 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## Leadership Scholarships

Leadership awards are based on leadership experience gained in high school, college, clubs, employment, community service, etc.

### CEUSA Leadership Awards

These awards give students an opportunity to work with Student Government at the College of Eastern Utah. Students applying for these scholarships must submit a resume outlining leadership capacities in which they have served and a two page essay detailing what they have learned from those experiences. Students selected will serve as officers with the College of Eastern Utah Student Association.

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## Leadership (cont.)

### Eastern Utah Ambassador Awards

Students applying for these scholarships must attend a special interview/campus visit day where they will be required to make a group presentation and have an individual interview for consideration. Students selected will serve as Eastern Utah Ambassadors for the Office of Admissions & Scholarships.

### CEU SUN Involvement Service Leadership Awards

Students applying for these scholarships must complete an application/interview process highlighting relevant leadership positions and community service experiences. They must also share their desired contribution to CEU and the community through this position. SUN Involvement Leaders selected will serve as liaisons with community agencies and programs involving students in a monthly service experience.

### Resident Advisor (RA) Awards

Students applying for Resident Advisor (RA) position must attend a group interview where they will be required to make a group presentation and have an individual interview. Students selected will be required to live in Residential Life and will serve as a Resident Advisor.

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### Western Undergraduate Exchange Award

These awards are available to nonresident students from the following participating states: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, North Dakota, New Mexico, Nevada, Oregon, South Dakota, Washington and Wyoming.

Students who qualify for these awards will have their non-resident tuition significantly reduced. Consideration for these awards is based on GPA, ACT or other test score, and application received date.
