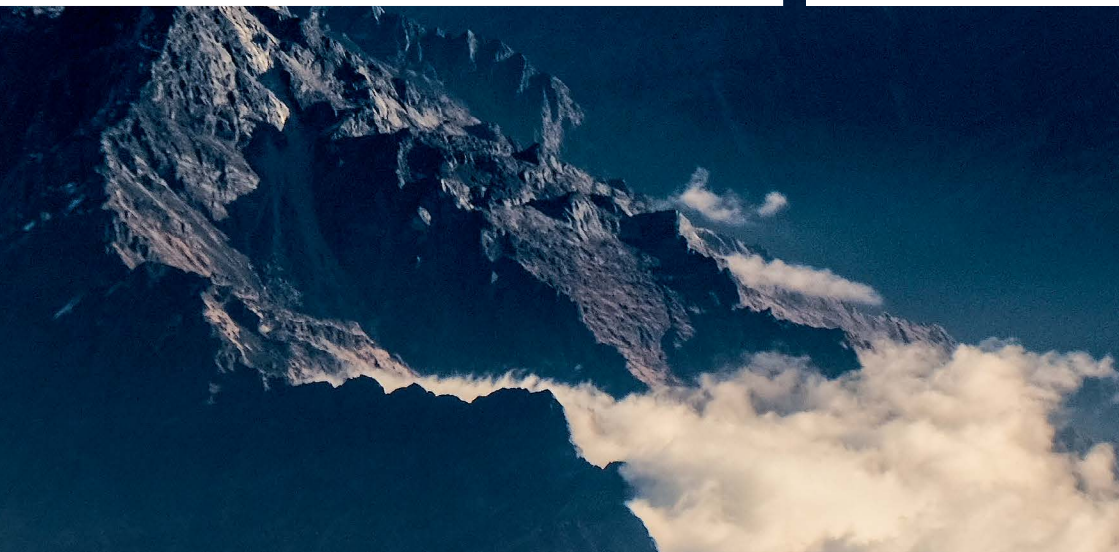

TWO YEARS / ERASMUS MUNDUS Joint Master's Degree. The program prepares students to identify and implement solutions for complex environmental challenges, especially in an international context. The program is operated by CEU, Lund University (Sweden), the University of Manchester (UK), the University of the Aegean (Greece), the University of Saskatchewan (Canada) and the Middlebury Institute of International Studies at Monterey (MIIS) (USA). MESPOM is supported by the European Commission's Erasmus + programme which provides scholarships for outstanding students that cover both living expenses and tuition fees.
