

SCIENCES PO STRONGLY OPPOSES THE HUNGARIAN GOVERNMENT'S PROPOSED LEGISLATION THAT WOULD EFFECTIVELY SHUT DOWN THE CENTRAL EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY IN BUDAPEST
