**Confirmation of legal status of „Central European University Private University“**

Vienna, 11.11.2019

The Agency for Quality Assurance and Accreditation Austria (AQ Austria) certifies herewith that CEU GmbH is an officially recognised Private University with the designation "Central European University Private University" according to the regulation of the Private Universities Act (PUG), BGBl. I Nr. 74/2011 (PUG).

The accreditation of CEU GmbH as a Private University with the designation "Central European University Private University" was carried out by decision of the Board of the Agency for Quality Assurance and Accreditation Austria (AQ Austria) with effect from 9 July 2019 for a period of six years.

According to § 3 PUG, Private Universities are entitled to award academic degrees to their graduates. These degrees are recognised Austrian academic degrees.

The Central European University Private University is entitled to offer the following degree programmes:

- The Bachelor programme "Culture, Politics and Society" is a six semester programme with 180 ECTS credits. The academic degree to be awarded is Bachelor of Arts, abbreviated BA. The programme is organised full-time. Up to 30 study places are offered. The language used is English. The programme is conducted in English.
- The Bachelor's programme "Philosophy, Politics and Economics" is a six-semester programme with 180 ECTS credits. The academic degree to be awarded is Bachelor of Arts, abbreviated BA. The programme is organised full-time. Up to 20 study places are offered. The programme is conducted in English.
- The Master's programme "International Public Affairs" is a four-semester programme with 120 ECTS credits. The academic degree to be awarded is Master of Arts, abbreviated to M.A. The programme is organised full-time. Up to 20 study places are offered. The programme is conducted in English.
- The Master's programme "Public Policy (Mundus MAPP)" is a four-semester programme with 120 ECTS credits. The academic degree to be awarded is Master of Arts, abbreviated to M.A. The programme is organised full-time. Up to 25 study places are offered. The programme is conducted in English.

- The Master's programme "Women's and Gender Studies (GEMMA)" is a four-semester programme with 120 ECTS credits. The academic degree to be awarded is Master of Arts, abbreviated to M.A. The programme is organised full-time. Up to 10 study places are offered. The programme is conducted in English.
- The Master's programme "Environmental Sciences, Policy and Management (MESPOM)" is a four-semester programme with 120 ECTS credits. The academic degree to be awarded is Master of Science, abbreviated to M.Sc. The programme is organised full-time. Up to 35 study places are offered. The programme is conducted in English

According to § 3 para. 6 and § 4 para. 4 PUG, the teaching staff and students of Private Universities receive treatment equal to that of teachers and students at Austrian State Universities.
