We offer advanced degree programs in comparative constitutional law, human rights and international business law accredited in the U.S. (not in Hungary). Our curriculum combines international and regional intellectual traditions, and offers students hands-on experience and internship opportunities. Outstanding faculty members, including visitors from leading universities around the world introduce students to legal reasoning, research and writing. The department is a consortium member of the China-Europe School of Law.

QUICK FACT / The department boasts several prestigious events every year, such as an annual conference on current issues of freedom of religion or the summer course on 'Constitution-building in Africa'. Our team takes part in the annual Willem Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot Competition.

Master of Laws in Comparative Constitutional Law (LLM)

ONE YEAR / This unique program focuses on examining constitutional issues in comparative, historical and social contexts in old, emerging and failing democracies.

Master of Laws in Human Rights (HR LLM), Master of Arts in Human Rights (HR MA)

ONE YEAR / These programs offer instruction in a variety of substantive human rights as well as in legal mechanisms and institutional processes that can be used to protect and promote human rights on the national, regional and international level.

Master of Laws in International Business Law (LLM)

ONE YEAR / This program focuses on international business transactions, the regulatory framework of international business and dispute resolution offering a comparative, cross-border perspective.

Doctor of Juridical Science (SJD) / Candidates holding a law degree and a master's degree pursue advanced legal studies that combine independent research with coursework in comparative constitutional law, human rights and international business law.

CAREER PATH / Graduates of the department pursue careers as policymakers, diplomats, scholars, human rights professionals, judges, arbitrators, consultants and lawyers in business and public administration.
